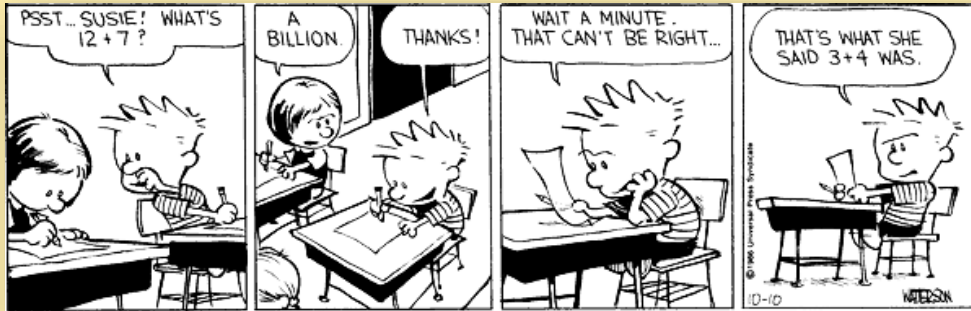

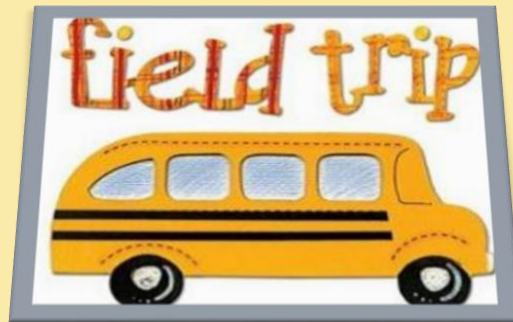
Mateo took part in Cricket Namibia U13 trails on 1 and 2 September in Windhoek

Congratulations to Emily Braune with her stallion, Baron, who competed in this prestigious event last weekend.

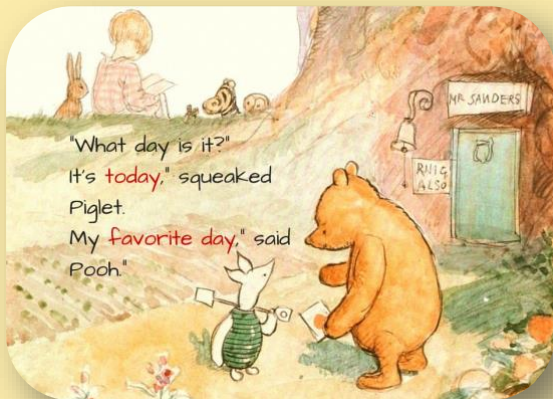
Emily competed in show jumping and dressage classes and either won or was placed in every event, leading to the following overall achievements and trophies:
